INFORMATION & POLICIES

REGISTRATION

1. There will be a registration day that all children must come to on Saturday, December 1st.
2. Registration will be from 9am to 11am. Come any time during these hours.
3. Teams will be picked this day.
4. Uniform sizes will also be determined on this day.
5. Team requests cannot be accepted.
6. No Exceptions on grade levels. They MUST be currently in Kindergarten at the youngest or 3rd grade at the oldest.

PRACTICE & GAMES

1. Practices are held once a week for one hour. The day and time will be relayed to parents after teams are assembled.
2. Games are held on Saturday mornings. These times will also be relayed to parents by the coaches after teams are assembled.
3. Games consist of two 15 minute halves with a continuous clock. There will be a stop every 5 minutes for subs and a break in the middle. They should last no longer than 45 minutes.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY

In signing this document, I, the parent (or legal guardian) of _____, authorize the participation of the above-named child in the First Baptist Church of Racine, OH Youth Basketball League. I recognize and understand that my child's participation in athletic activities involves the risk of injury and even death from a variety of causes including but not limited to dehydration, accidents, collisions, equipment defect, falls, strains, and negligence from coaches or referees. In assuming these risks, with the knowledge that doing so grants privilege to my child to participate in the league, I release, indemnify, and hold harmless First Baptist Church of Racine from any and all liability, loss, personal injury, sickness or death, as well as property damages, costs, or expenses, of any nature (including attorney's fees) whatsoever arising out of my child's participation in the basketball league. I acknowledge that during the league that my child must conform and adhere to all applicable policies, rules, regulations, and standards of conduct as established by the Church to ensure the best interest, comfort, and welfare of him/her as well as the other participants.

CONSENT TO MEDICAL TREATMENT

Youth Basketball League Rules, Regulations, and Remarks

First Baptist Church of Racine

General Information

- Cost: \$45—Cash or Check Only
- Grades: Kindergarten—3rd Grade
- Dates: Saturdays, January 12th—February 23rd

Game Format

- Games will consist of two 15-minute halves with a 5 minute half-time.
- The clock will stop every 5 minutes for substitutions.
- No scores will be kept for the K5 and First grade groups.
- There will be no timeouts during games.
- The clock will be stopped on all whistles during the last minute of every 5 minute segment.

Specific Rules for Game Play at FBC Racine

- Each team will play straight Man-to-Man defense. No zone defenses are to be played.
- Double teaming is not allowed; however, help defense is encouraged. Help is allowed in the events of screens, fast breaks where another defender is not available, and drives into the lane where the offensive player is within arm's reach.
- Defensive players must stay within arm's reach of the player they're guarding.
- Full court presses are not allowed. Defenses will pick up at half court.
- Steals off the dribble are not allowed. Steals off the pass ARE allowed.
- Situations where a point is scored in the wrong goal will be treated as a turnover, but no points given to the opposing team.
- Free throws will be for 2nd and 3rd grade teams only. This will only be for shooting fouls. We will not have bonus situations.

Notes to parents

First, we want to thank you for considering our league and we hope to fulfill all of the expectations that your child has for playing. We do realize that some of the specific rules aren't ideal, but after three seasons of trying to get the best overall experience, these are what we've decided on. This is because our goals are to see each child improve fundamentally. That simply cannot be done at these ages when our league and coaches are more concerned with winning than teaching skills and sportsmanship.

Also, we want you to know that, aside from this league, we have a functioning church that desires to serve God and the families of this community. We realize that families struggle in a multitude of different areas. We are here to help. If you have questions, need counseling, or need anything else, please let us know.
